Measure B proposes changing Sunnyvale's City Council election system to six districts and a directly elected mayor. This proposal:


- Would help protect the City against a lawsuit under the California Voting Rights Act; and
- Would ask voters to elect councilmembers from six geographic areas of the city.

If Measure B passes, you would vote for a councilmember from the district where you live, and everyone would vote for mayor.

- November 2020 ballot: even-numbered districts and mayor
- November 2022 ballot: odd-numbered districts
